

## FAQ: (Frequently Asked Questions)

Q: What kind of brakes can be used?

A: Brush - brakes that brush against the outside diameter of the tire when applied.

Caliper – brakes that squeeze the sides of the wheel rim when applied.

Disc - brakes that squeeze a rotor, attached to the wheel hub, when applied.

Drag – brakes that drag the pavement when applied.

Q: For the brake types listed above, with the exception of drag brakes, does it matter if the brakes are on the back or the front wheels or both?

A: It is better to have them on the rear wheels unless you put them on all four.

Q: What kind of ballast can be used?

A: If lead or steel shot is used, it must be encased so that the shots do not leak out.

Q: What are the requirements for steering?

A: Steering must be operable and reliable. No handheld rope or cable steering can be used.

Q: Should there be a concern about width to height ratio?

A: Weight should be concentrated in the bottom half of the car.

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
